Note: In view of COVID-19 Pandemic, it will be mandatory for the candidates appearing for the entrance examination to use mask, follow social distancing and sanitization norms

Only medically fit candidate on the day of entrance test will be allow to appear for the entrance test.

- **About Entrance Examination -**

Entrance Examination will be conducted in online mode for admission to first year MSW course

- **Venues:**

Online Entrance Examination will be conducted at the Online Examination Center, KBC NMU campus, Jalgaon on 31st December, 2020.

Admission Process:

The student will have to fill up online form as available on the university website <http://www.nmu.ac.in>, a form will be generated for the students applying for Entrance Test. Student should take the print out of the computer generated filled form and keep it safely with you at the end of admission process. Student has to submit hard copy of application form along with attested photo copies after final selection for the course at Department of Social Work, KBCNMU, Jalgaon. Student has to pay the application fees Rs. 200/- through online mode.

1. **It is mandatory for all the students to have Original Valid Photo ID card prof at the time of entrance examination.**
2. **It is mandatory to appear for Entrance Test for admission to the above-mentioned course.**

- **Eligibility Criteria:**

Candidates appeared for any **Bachelor's Degree** from recognized University.

A Bachelor's Degree of minimum of 3 years duration or its equivalent (under the 10+2+3 or 10+2+2+1 year bridge course pattern of study or any pattern fulfilling the mandatory requirement of 15 years formal education).

The minimum requirement for admission to the M.S.W. degree programme is **Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Home Science, or any other faculty or are cognized University with a minimum of 45% marks.** Higher academic degrees or diplomas in Social Sciences and experience of working with people will be an additional qualification.

Eligibility Criteria and Reservation Quota:

All reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criterion specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(a) Reservation for backward class category candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra state is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates appearing for the entrance test, Backward class candidates shall mention the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form for Entrance Test .

(b) Reservation for wards of defiance service personnel:

Five percent (5%) seats out of total sanctioned intake capacity (50) of the department of social work each defense wing shall be reserved for wards of ex-service personal who are from Maharashtra.

(c) Reservation for persons with disability candidates:

Five percent (5%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of the department shall be reserved for candidates with disability.

The allotment of seats reserved for the candidates with disability shall be done on the basis of merit. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall here to submit the Physical Disability certificates issued by competent authority.

Note: -Candidates with disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the university.

(d) If the reservation quota remains vacant then 2% seats of total vacant reserved seats will be offered to SBC category.

(e) Reservation for EWS (Economical Weaker Section) Candidate: As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो-4019/ह.ड.31/16-अ, dated 12thFebruary, 2019, 10% seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates. These seats shall be filled the Competent Authority through entrance test as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time.

(f) If sufficient candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University area are not available for admission, candidates from other universities will be considered. Similarly, if candidates from other universities are not available for admission, the candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University will be considered for admission. There will be separate merit list for other university students.

(g) Any change in terms of reservation from government side will be enforced with immediate.

• **Distribution of Seats:-**

- a) 50% seats would be reserved for the candidates who have qualified from the Social Work discipline (BSW) in each of the above university area.
- b) Candidates graduated from KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon: Home University 90 % seats
- c) Candidates graduated from other University (Other than KBC NMU.)...10 % seats

Deputed Candidates:

Candidates being deputed by Government or private Organization should apply through proper channel with appropriate NOC issued by the employer. Direct application will not be considered

- **Entrance Examination Details:**

The Entrance Test will consist of:

1. The entrance examination will have conducted online mode at Online Examination Center KBCNMU Campus, Jalgaon.
2. The question paper will consist of on 60 multiple Choice Questions (MCQ).
3. There will be no negative marking.
4. Final result will consist of Online Entrance Examination marks obtained by the candidate out of 60 marks.

- **Stages of Admission Entrance Test**

Stage I: Prerequisites–

- Read the instructions given in the brochure carefully
- Before proceeding for filling up the Entrance form ensure the following
 - (a) You should have your own E-mail account, Mobile number etc.
 - (b) You should have scanned copy of your original documents with you.
 - (c) You should have with you Debit Card, Credit Card, Phone Pay, BHIM, Google Pay etc. for online payment
 - (d) Visit the link <http://nmu.ac.in>
- Fill up the online application form strictly as per the given instructions.
- After submitting the online form, Form Application Number will be generated by the system
- You have to note down this number for future correspondence.
- **PLEASE NOTE THE FORM NO.** For future reference.
- Print the Application Form and keep it with you safely at the end of admission process. You have to submit application form along with attested photocopies of necessary documents after final selection for course at Department.
- You have to upload scanned copies of original documents.

Stage -II: Display of eligible candidates list for entrance examination test:

- After scrutiny of online application the list of eligible candidates for appearing to Entrance Test will be available on the web site and will also be displayed on the notice board of the Social Work Department.
- The list of eligible candidates for appearing to Entrance Test will not be published in any newspaper or will not be communicated to any candidate personally by post.
- If the candidate has any objection related to the Eligible Candidate list he/she may submit his/her objection with proper documents in written form to the Department of Social Work, Kavaytri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University through email-mwkbcmu@gmail.com within specified date and time limit.
