North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, established on 15th August, 1990 under the Maharashtra Universities Act, XXIX in 1989, started its academic and administrative functioning from the academic year 1991-92. Within the span of 3 years, the University is recognized under section 2 (f) in 1991 and 12 (B) in 1994 under the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956. The jurisdiction of the University is extended over three districts i.e. Jalgaon, Dhule and Nandurbar, a pre-dominantly tribal and rural area of Khandesh region. The University has opened its doors of higher education to mostly first generation learners of this area. Access, equity and academic excellence are the thrust areas of the University's educational endeavor.

The Eklavya Training Centre has been established to cater the needs of tribal and rural students, particularly in Nandurbar district and started functioning w.e.f. 15.08.1992. The Center conducts Chanakya Competitive Examination Coaching Scheme at 20 affiliated colleges. The Honorable Vice Chancellor has requested to the then District Collector, Nandurbar for 25 acres of government land for establishing a Tribal Academy consisting of Model College, Community College, Sports Academy and Hostels keeping in mind the upliftment of the aspiring tribes and backward students. The proposal has been accepted by the District Collector and the land measurement procedure has also been completed. The further procedure of Land Acquisition is under progress as per the Government norms. The Honourable Vice Chancellor has submitted a proposal of Community College to the Government of Maharashtra at the Eklavya Training Centre, Nandurbar. The Government has accepted the proposal and sanctioned a Community College at the Eklavya Training Centre. This Community College will fulfill the employment opportunities available in the local area and also the social needs of the community. The target group of the community college will be 12th passed students, school dropouts, rural youth, rural women, existing workforce that wants to update its skills and all who want skill based and need based education at an affordable price.

Mission

- To enhance and build capacities of tribal and other backwards groups.
- To provide equal opportunity and ensure human development of marginalized tribal society.
- To develop the course to enhance their skills to earn income.
- To develop trainer of trainer from own community at the livelihood base of agriculture and forestry.

Objectives

- To make higher education relevant to the learner and the community;
- To integrate relevant skills into the higher education system.
- To provide skill based education to students currently pursuing higher education, but actually interested in entering the workforce at the earliest opportunity.
- To provide employable and certifiable skill based on National Occupational Standards (NOSs) with necessary general education to Senior Secondary School pass-outs, with general education and or/ vocational education background.
- To provide for up-gradation and certification of traditional /acquired skills of the learners irrespective of their age.
- To provide opportunities for community-based lifelong learning by offering courses of general interest to the community for personal development and interest;
- To provide opportunity for vertical mobility to move to higher education in the future.
- To offer bridge courses to certificate holders of general / vocational education, so as to bring them at par with appropriate NSQF (National Skill Qualification Framework) level.
- To provide entrepreneurial orientation along with required skill training for self-employment and entrepreneurship development.

1. Diploma in Agriculture and Natural Resource Management Skills.

Diploma in Agriculture and Natural Resource Management Skills is a one year diploma course. The main objectives of this course are to develop sustainable management of natural resources in achieving food and nutritional, environmental and livelihood security in the tribal region and also to develop cost effective, eco-friendly conservation and management technology for higher input use efficiency, agricultural productivity and profitability with deteriorating natural resource basis of the tribal region.

The thrust areas are land resources characterization, management and land use planning, water management, soil health and nutrient management, management of problematic soil, such as i.e. saline, alkaline, acidic and water log soils, soil and water conservation and watershed management, crop diversification, rain-fed/dry land farming, agro forestry management, weed management, development of integrated farming system arid land management, evolution of natural conservation technology.

2. Community College may like to provide.

The Vision of the Community College is to empower the disadvantaged and the underprivileged. Imparting them an appropriate skills development program and making them gainfully employed. The major aim is to restore the human right to education denied to the unreached to earn their livelihood. It is expected to promote job oriented, work related skill-based and life coping education. It mainly concentrates on the urban poor, rural poor, tribal poor and the women.

The curriculum of the Community Colleges: in order to rope in the disadvantages person , the Community College system envisages access, flexibility in curriculum and teaching methodology, cost effectiveness and equal opportunity in collaboration with industrial , commercial and service sector of the local area and responding to the social needs and issues of the local community, internship and job placement with in the local area , promotion of self- employment and small business development , declaration of competence and eligibility for employment.

Two Semesters are in this course pattern.

4. Hours of attendance.

Community College will start at 02.30 P.M. to 05.40 P.M. i.e. 3 Hours a day.

Total 900 hours in year.

5. Minimum Eligibility Qualification for Admission.

(I) The minimum educational qualification for admission into Community College will be Class 12th pass or equivalent from any recognized board or university.

(II) There shall be no age bar for admission in the Community College.

(III) Available Intake capacity is 50 seats with reservation as per Govt. of Maharashtra.

6. Admission Fees and Scholarship.

(I) Admission fees as per course Rs.10, 000/- (Ten Thousand only)

(II) Scholarship of Rs.1, 000/- per month will be provided to the student at the end of each Semester, subject to their satisfactory attendance and on successfully qualifying the end Semester examination without any back paper/back log. In the event of short attendance or Failure of students in the end semester examination, she/he will not be entitled for scholarship during that semester. No arrears shall be admissible to the student for such period.

7. Academic Session and others

The academic session will start in August 2016 and will end July 2017. All Gazetted and other holidays shall be applicable as per Govt. Calendar. The college authorities may, however conduct classes on Sundays and holidays except national holidays, if required.

8. Medium of instructions & Examination.

The medium of teaching / instruction shall Marathi/ English.

9. Examination.

The semester pattern examination shall be conducted by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon after completion of the prescribed hour every six months. After successful completion of the course North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon will award certificates NSQF Level-5.

10. General Rules and Regulation.

(i) The candidate has to abide all the rules & regulations prescribed in the institution. These rules are meant for the safety of candidates and can be changed at any time without any intimation.

(ii) Speaking loudly & roaming here & there without any purpose is strictly prohibited.

(iii) Smoking, drinking, playing of cards in this institution is strictly prohibited. Any student found guilty will be fined and can be expelled from the institution.

(iv) Late arrival in the classes will be allowed seriously and may lead to absence from the class.

(v) The institution will not be responsible for any loss of personal Goods.

(vi) The Candidates are advised to be careful while working in workshop/labs. The institution will not be responsible for any mis-happening/ Accident occurs while in the workshop /Labs.

(vii) The candidates have to qualify the minimum attendance and internal seasonal criteria as prescribed by UGC and North Maharashtra University Jalgaon. Failing which they will be debarred from appearing on the Board of Examination.
