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Report on Nanostructure 2014

'NANOSTRUCTURE 2014' International Conference on Structural Nano Composites was organised from 20-21 May, 2014 in Madrid, Spain by the Robert Gordon University Aberdeen UK and CSIC, Madrid Spain. The conference was inaugurated on 19 May 2014 at 4.00 PM in the convention Hall of the CSIC, Madrid and presentations were started from 20 – 21 May 2014 since 9.00 AM to 6.00 PM on both the days. The poster session was held on 20 May 2014 from 6.30 to 7.30 PM. There were sixteen technical sessions for invited lectures and oral presentations besides poster presentations. I had delivered my first lecture on **'Synthesis and characterisation of hybrid core-shell (inorganic/organic) nanostructured materials and their effect of millable polyurethane nanocomposites'** and second lecture on **'Cable type three-dimensional cotton thread based conductive nanotextile for LPG sensing at room temperature'** on first day i.e 20 May 2014.
