**Notification regarding online Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Work Examination
(March 2023)**

The Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon has conducted Online Pre-Ph.D. Entrance Test in the month of April, 2022. After this, the University has allocated guides to the PET qualified and PET exempted students and also conducted the course work workshop in the month of February, 2023. Now, the University has planned to conduct **Online Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Work Examination on March 4th and 5th, 2023 (Saturday and Sunday)**, for those students who have already completed course work workshop. The details of this examination are as below:

a) The details of Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course work and syllabi for Pre-Ph.D. Theory Courses is available on university website [www.nmu.ac.in].

b) There shall be two papers

Paper 1 - (PHD 001): Research Methodology and Research and Publication Ethics (RM-RPE) and

Paper 2 - (PHD 002) : Subject Specific Course

c) The Examination of Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Paper- I & Paper-II will be conducted at **Online Examination Center, School of Mathematical Sciences Building(New), Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon** through Online Mode. Both papers will consist of only objective type questions and Each paper shall consist of 50 questions (2 marks) each with a duration of 1 hour held on **March 4th and 5th, 2023** in ONE session as under:

d) There will be no negative marking.

e) Questions and Multiple-Choice Answers will be in asked in both languages i.e. English and Marathi.

f) There are some candidates who will appear only for **Paper I / Paper II / Both Paper I and Paper II**. Accordingly, links shall be provided for the necessary examination.

g) **Hall ticket with Username and Password for exam shall be made available in the candidate's Ph.D Process login.**

h) All the necessary instructions regarding the exam shall be printed in the Hall Ticket.

i) Result / Score obtained shall not be displayed after finishing the exam to the candidate. And **shall be made available to the candidate on portal after two days of exam.**

Paper 3 - (PHD 003) : Guide's Course Based on Research Area:

Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Paper-III is Guide's Course based on research area selected for Ph.D. For its examination, the guide should ask the student to deliver TWO seminars (on the selected research area) of 1 hour duration each using LCD and prepare the reports. The candidate will have to write Review paper on his/her own research area. The weightage for each seminar will be 40 marks and 20 marks for review article (Total marks 100). The guide has to submit the reports of seminars and review article along with marks list [both hard copy and soft copy CD] to Research Section through the Director of School/ Institute/Principal of the College on or before **March 31st, 2023**.

The evaluation of the Seminar components will be based on following four sub- heads.

Standard of passing

The candidates are required to obtain minimum marks in Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III as given below, to qualify the Pre-Ph.D. Course Work Examination.

Notes :

1. Only those candidates who will obtain the minimum required marks in each Paper, separately, as mentioned above, will be considered for final preparation of result.
2. Only those candidates, who qualify the Pre-Ph.D. Course Work Examination, will be eligible for submission of outline of Ph.D. research work and further process.

For Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates thirty minutes extra time shall be provided separately for paper-I and Paper-II. They will also be provided the services of a scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate. Those Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by making prior request (at least one week before the date of Pre-Ph.D. Theory Examination) in writing to the Pro-Vice Chancellor. Extra time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically Handicapped candidates.

General Notes:

1. All provisionally registered student, those who have not paid provisional registration fee till date, are requested to pay the fee before Course Work Examination February-2023.
2. The registered students of PET-2019 (who were not completed Course Work and/or failed the course work Examination) those who have not paid fee yet, they are requested to pay the fee as per notification before **March 31st, 2023**.
