## 2) Revised process for the MSc (All subjects) and MA (Geography) online admissions:

### a) Display of available category wise seats (seat matrix) for CAP round(s)

The university shall publish the information about institutes, courses offered, sanctioned intake and number of seats available for each category before the commencement of each CAP round(s).

### b) Filling up and confirmation of online option form through his/her login having preferences of courses and institutions before CAP round-I/II. Candidates may fill **minimum one and maximum thirty** choices of institutes and courses in the order of their preference. The option form once confirmed by the candidate through their login shall be considered for allotment for that CAP round and cannot be changed for that particular CAP round. **It is mandatory to fill fresh option form for each CAP round(s).**

### c) Display of provisional allotment of CAP Round indicating allotted institute and Course in candidate login.

### d) During the CAP rounds(s), before accepting the allotted seat a candidate can opt to **'FREEZE**, or **'FLOAT'** the choice of academic program for subsequent round(s), of seat allocation, as provided below: -

#### i) **Freeze:** Candidates accept the offered seat and they do not want to participate in any further rounds of seat allocation. Such Candidates will not be considered in subsequent rounds of admission.

#### ii) **Float:** Candidates accept the offered seat and indicate that, if admission to an academic program of higher preference in any Institution is offered, they will accept it. Else, they will continue with the currently accepted academic program. Such candidates will be considered in subsequent round (Round- II) of admission.

**फ्लोट:** उमेदवार त्यांना देऊ करण्यात आलेली जागा स्वीकारतील आणि इतर कोणत्याही संस्थेमध्ये वरच्या पसंतीक्रमाच्या शैक्षणिक अध्ययनक्रमाला प्रवेश देऊ करण्यात आला तर, तो स्वीकारतील असा निर्देश करतील. अन्यथा त्यांनी स्वीकारलेल्या शैक्षणिक अध्ययनक्रमदेखील स्वीकारतील, अशा उमेदवारांचा त्यानंतरचा प्रवेश फेऱ्यामध्ये विचार केला जाईल.

#### iii) For Candidates who choose the Float option, and secures a seat of his choice of higher preference, then it would automatically result in the forfeiture of the seat accepted by the candidate in the earlier round.

iv) Float options will not be available to a candidate who is offered admission to his first choice, and it is mandatory to confirm admission at respective college/school.

- e) Reporting and accepting the offered seat (confirmation of admission) as per the allotment of the CAP Round I and II by the candidate.
- f) If the candidate has allotted first preference as per the options filled by the candidate, it is mandatory to report to the respective college/school and confirm the admission. Such candidate will not be allowed to participate in further CAP rounds.

### 3) Admissions in institutional (management) quota:

The Director/Principal of the affiliated College shall carry out the admissions for these seats in the following manner.

- (a) Admissions shall be made in a transparent manner and strictly as per the merit of the candidates who have applied for CAP.
- (b) Application for institutional (management) quota should begin after completion of CAP rounds.
- (c) Aspiring candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria as notified by the University, from time to time, shall apply to the Principal or Director of the respective institution for admission at the Institution level.
- (d) The institution may give admission to the applicants on the basis of their merit derived from merit list declared by the University.
- (e) The institution shall prepare and display the merit list of the candidates to be filled in at the institution level, in the institutional quota, on the notice board and shall publish the same on the website of the institution.
- (f) The institution intending to surrender the institutional quota (in part or full) of specified courses to the CAP shall communicate five days before the display of seat matrix of CAP Round - I and the same shall be allotted as per the rules of CAP.

### 4) Institution level round:

If the seats remain vacant after all CAP rounds, the said seats shall be filled in by the institution through institution level round with the prior approval of the University.

## 5) Refund of fee after cancellation of admission:

- (a) The candidate shall apply for cancellation and submit signed copy of application for cancellation of admission to the institution.
- (b) After receiving admission cancellation request from the candidate, the institution shall cancel the admission immediately online and generate online acknowledgement of cancellation of admission through institution login and issue a signed copy to the candidate.
- (c) No candidate will be allowed to cancel his/her admission without paying complete fees of the course for which he/she got admitted.
- (d) The candidate cancelling his/her admission within a period of seven days from the date of his/her admission, deduction to the tune of 10% of total amount of tuition fee plus Rs. 500/- will be made towards administrative processing charges.
- (e) The candidate cancelling his/her admission within a period of 30 days from the date of his/her admission, deduction to the tune of 25% of total amount of tuition fee plus Rs. 500/- will be made towards administrative processing charges.
- (f) The candidate cancelling his/her admission after the period of 30 days from the date of his/her admission, refund towards any kind of fees will not be made.
- (g) No refund will be made to any candidate admitted through industry sponsored quota.
