- (a) 1) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
 - 2) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil. /Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SET:



1) The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic affairs) of the University concerned.

2) NET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SET is not conducted. However, Ph.D. degree shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor in such disciplines.

NOTES :

- 1. A relaxation of 5% marks be provided (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D.Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- 2. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized University, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
- 3. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as the Masters' level for the candidates belonging to scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non creamy Layer) /Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision: (b) Deaf and Hard of hearing: (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy: (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness. Multiple disabilities from amongst person under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- 4. 4% reservation will be observed for physically handicapped candidates as per Government Resolution dated 29.05.2019.
- 5. 30% Reservation for women shall be observed as per Government norms.
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate for the candidate belonging to the DT-A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC and SBC categories, as per Govt. of Maharashtra Resolution dated 16th December, 2017, issued by the competent authority valid till the date 31.03.2025.
- 7. The Reserved category candidate should submit their Cast Validity Certificate as per the Government Resolution, wherever applicable.
- 8. As per Government Resolution No.BCC-2016/PK 228A/16/16 B. dated 29th May, 2017. A/B/C/D/ points in VJ/NT Category are interchangeable.
- Weightage shall be given to the applicants who have published work of high quality and who have succeeded in bringing funds by submitting research projects to various funding agencies such as UGC/ CSIR/ DST/DBT/TWAS/ ISSR/AICTE etc.
- 10. Candidate belonging to specific reserved category from Maharashtra State alone shall be considered for reserved post and they are required to submit Caste Validity certificate at the time of joining.
- 11. Candidates from reserved category, who are domiciled outside the Maharashtra State will be treated as Open category candidates as per Govt. G.R. No. CBC-1290/23116/ pra.kra.378/avaka-5 dated 24.08.95.
- 12. Candidates having cleared State Eligibility Test (SET) from the State other than Maharashtra State shall not be considered for appointment.

- 16. Knowledge of Marathi Language is desirable for all posts.
- 17. Application fee of Rs.750/- (for open category) and Rs. 375/- (for candidates belongings to reserved category) should be paid by online mode only.
- 18. Applicants shall apply through online mode only from <u>05.06.2025 to 20.06.2025</u> through web site link of the university: https//apps.nmu.ac.in/recruitment/ Also candidates are informed to submit hard copy of online form along with testimonials in Two copies with online payment receipt. The last date of submission of hard copy of application is on or before <u>25.06.2025</u> upto 5.00 p.m.
- 19. A candidate furnishing incorrect or false information shall stand disqualified at any stage.
- 20 For the above posts retired persons who have not attained the age of 65 years may also apply.
- 21. Applicant who wishes to be considered for more than one post should apply separately for each post.
- 22. Mere possession of minimum qualifications does not confer any right to be called for interview and /or selection.
- 23. Applicants already employed should submit their hard copy of applications through proper channel.
- 24. Applications received after the last date and/or not submitted through proper channel and/ or incomplete application will not be considered.
