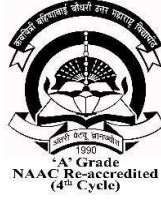

1. Nature and Duration of the Course

B.A. Social Science is a full-time course of three/four years (6/8 semesters) duration after HSC (12th Standard) with Multiple Entry Multiple Exit Options as per the NEP-2020. Under this program, students pursuing a B.A. Social Science with Majors and Minors will have the opportunity to tailor their education according to their interests and career goals. Students will have options to choose a major from Economics or Political Science and a minor from Management or Statistics.

2. Intake Capacity: 60

2.1 Reservation and admission criteria:

Reservation of seats as per the rules of Government of Maharashtra for the candidates belonging to reserved category from the Maharashtra state. Admissions will be given based on the merit list of marks obtained in H.S.C. (Class XII).

2.2 Eligibility:

Candidate who has passed H.S.C. Class XII (10 + 2 Pattern) from Maharashtra State Board or any such recognized board.

OR

Candidate who has passed MCVC course from Maharashtra State Education Board.

4. Degree Awarded

Under this program, students pursuing a B.A. Social Science will get following degree based on the chosen Majors and Minors by him/her:

- B.A. Social Science with Major Economics and Minor Management.
- B.A. Social Science with Major Economics and Minor Statistics.
- B.A. Social Science with Major Political Science and Minor Management
- B.A. Social Science with Major Political Science and Minor Statistics.
