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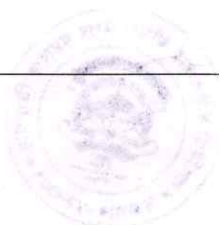


1 About Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon

The Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University (KBCNMU), Jalgaon (Formerly known as North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon) established on 15th August, 1990 (after separating it from the parent University of Pune) under the Maharashtra Universities Act, XXIX of 1989, started its academic and administrative functioning from the academic year 1991-92. Within the span of 3 years, the University is recognized under section 2 (f) in 1991 and 12 (B) in 1994 under the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956. The jurisdiction of the University is extended over three districts i.e. Jalgaon, Dhule and Nandurbar which is a pre-dominantly tribal and rural area of Khandesh region. The University has opened its doors of higher education to mostly "first generation learners" of this area. Access, equity and academic excellence are the thrust areas of the University's educational endeavour.

The university campus is located about 8 km away from Jalgaon city and 1.5 km away from the National Highway No. 46. It occupies an area of 660 acres (2.7 km²) on the banks of Giran river and on a hilly terrain (above mean sea level 810 ft.). The university boasts of impressive infrastructural facilities, such as administrative, examination, and library buildings, School/Institute-specific structures, numerous classrooms, technologically up-to-date laboratories, advanced research facilities, a Senate Hall, a Convocation Auditorium, an indoor sports stadium, a Health Center, a Guest House, a Shikshak Bhavan, a VVIP Guest House, hostels, Staff quarters, a Central School (Kendriya Vidyalaya), a library, post office, bank, ATM, and a Shopping Complex, all of which have been established within the university's short 24-year existence. These resources have proven to be more than sufficient to meet the needs of the teaching and non-teaching staff, students, researchers, and stakeholders.

Under this tender scope, the university administration wants to install the CCTV network within the campus, to secure it. This will include Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Dome and Bullet camera system with NVR and supporting infrastructure.

6 INSTRUCTIONS AND TENDER INFORMATION

The Finance and Accounts Officers, Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University (KBCNMU), Jalgaon invites "Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning (SITC) of CCTV Camera System" from Manufacturer/ Distributors/ Authorized Dealers. The details in this regard are given below.

1. Procedure to submit the tender: All eligible/ interested bidders are required to be enrolled on Portal <https://mahatenders.gov.in> before downloading tender documents and participate in e-tendering. The vendors should submit online tender in two bid systems i.e. Technical Bid and Commercial / Financial Bid. (BOQ)
2. Technical Bid: The technical bid shall contain the following documents. The Bidder must Scan the signed documents and upload all these documents online with first page in technical bid compulsorily. All the documents must be valid and self-attested by bidder. Non-submission of following requested documents may lead to rejection of offers.
3. Financial Bid:-The tendering authority will first open the Technical Bid documents of all bidders and after scrutinizing these documents, technical committee will shortlist the Bidders who are eligible for Financial Bidding process. Financial bid will be open for shortlisted eligible bidders only. The Financial bid should be submitted only online mode by bidder in a specified format in the form of BOQ excel sheet given on www.mahatender.gov.in, in which, the supplier shall fill up the rates in the mentioned column, as offered by him.
4. Bidder should have valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) obtained from any Certifying Authorities, while submitting the bid online.
5. The specifications/details for the work "Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning (SITC) of CCTV Camera System" is provided in the e-tender documents.
6. The Technical and Financial bid shall be submitted only online mode as per the e-tender schedule.
7. Bidder may be invited for discussions in university office, if needed/required.
8. The Bidders are strictly advised to follow the dates and times allocated to each stage. As indicated in the time schedule. All the online activities are time tracked and the Electronic Tendering System enforces time-locks that ensure that no activity or transaction can take place outside the Start and End Dates and Time of the Stage as defined in the tender schedule. At the sole discretion of the Tender Authority, the time schedule of the Tender stages may be extended.
9. Rate to be quoted should be mentioned at appropriate place provided schedule (BOQ in .xls format) by the bidder. Moreover the rate should not be quoted



- anywhere else in the e-tender booklet as well as in the blank pages.
10. The University reserves the right to decide whether to open or not open the commercial Bid of the supplier and no objection of any supplier shall be entertained on any ground whatsoever it may be regarding this.
 11. No bid shall be accepted without online payment of earnest money deposit (EMD) and tender fee, unless it is exempted or waved off under specific conditions or eligibility criteria.
 12. The rate should be inclusive of all taxes, duties, Installation F.O.R. delivery at respective Schools/ Departments in the campus of the KBCNMU, Jalgaon.
 13. The rate should be offered only for the item as mentioned in the Schedule for BOQ.

6.1 SECURITY DEPOSIT in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee/Cash.

The successful bidder to whom the purchase order is given shall be required to submit the Security Deposit equivalent to 5% of total value of invoice in the form of a bank performance guarantee or by online payment mode NEFT/RTGS for the period of 60 days beyond warranty period of 5 years. The Bank Guarantee should be of a Nationalized Bank and needs to be submitted within 7 days from the date of receipt of purchase order and the same will be forfeited if the supplier fails / refuses to provide the satisfactory services during the period of warranty. (As per Annexure-H) Please note that this security deposit will not carry any interest. If the bidder fails to



submit the security deposit, then the second lowest quoted bidder will be issued the similar purchase order, or the University withholds the total authority for the necessary action to be taken. The Security deposit will be forfeited if the supplier fails to execute the purchase order, within the mentioned criteria and period.

6.2 COSTS & CURRENCY

The offer must be given in Indian Rupees (INR) only, inclusive of all the taxes, bifurcating both direct and indirect taxes, including GST.

6.3 COST OF BIDDING

The Bidder shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of its tender, and the Purchaser will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tendering process.

6.4 OFFER (Validity Period, Acceptance & Jurisdiction)

The tender offer must be valid for 180 days from the date of opening of the tender. However, the University reserves the right to extend this period for sufficient days, if the bidder accepts the same in writing.

The KBCNMU reserves the right to accept or reject or cancel any tender or relax any part of the tender offer without assigning any reason thereof.

6.5 FIXED PRICE

The Commercial Offer quoted should be F.O.R the University Campus (delivery to be given to concerned department) of KBCNMU, Jalgaon. The rate quoted by the bidder should inclusive of all the taxes, duties, installation and freight, Insurance, etc. No price variation shall be asked for relating to increase in customs duty, excise or any other tax, transport charges, dollar price variation, etc.

The **Technical Offer** must be submitted in an organized and neat manner. Each page of the document must bear seal and signature of the authorized signatory. Documents submitted must have relevance with the technical qualification. If only summary is required, booklet is not to be submitted in this regard. No documents, brochures, leaflet, etc. shall be submitted in loose form or which have not been asked. Brochures, leaflet, etc., for the selected products only



are to be submitted. Proper references for such documents must be mentioned in index. Bidder will be liable for disqualification if unwanted/irrelevant documents are submitted.

6.6.2 ENVELOPE-II (COMMERCIAL OFFER)

Bidder shall submit their prices only in the Bid Form (Appendix) given in the bid's financial document. Price quoted other than the bid form is liable to be rejected. The Bid Form must be filled in completely, without any errors, erasures or alterations. Rate quoted shall be **all-inclusive** Price i.e. considering taxes, duties, levies, GST, transport, installation and any other relevant charges etc.

6.7 COMPLETENESS OF TECHNICAL OFFER

Technical details must be filled in correct technical information of the product being offered must be filled in. Filling up of the Technical Detail Form using terms such as "OK", "accepted", "noted", "as given in brochure / manual" is not acceptable. The Purchaser may treat offers not adhering to these guidelines as non-acceptable. Price quotation accompanied by vague and conditional expressions such as "subject to immediate acceptance", "subject to confirmation before sales", etc. will be treated as being at variance and shall be liable for rejection. Conditional bids will also be treated as rejected bids and will not be considered at all.

Provide technical data sheets / Literature / product brochure of each item along with the tender offer, to treat the offer as complete offer.

6.8 ERASURES OR ALTERATIONS AND SIGNING OF TENDER OFFERS

The original Tender Offer shall be signed by the Bidder or a person or persons duly authorized in writing to bind the Bidder to the terms and conditions of the tender and the contract. Such authorization shall be indicated by power-of-attorney accompanying the tender offer. The person or person signing the Tender Offer shall initial all pages of the Tender Offer, except for un-amended printed literature. The Tender Offer shall contain no interlineations, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by the Bidder, in that case such corrections shall be initiated by the person or person signing the offer.

Safety & Security of all the supplied equipment's shall be the responsibility of the vendor till completion of the project work as per the Purchase Order.

6.11 SUBMISSION OF TENDER OFFERS

Tender offers shall be received by Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, online before the time and date specified in the schedule of the tender notice. In the event of the specified date for the submission of tender offers being



declared a holiday, the offers will be received up to the appointed time on the next working day.

7 AWARD CRITERIA

7.1 TENDER OPENING AND METHOD OF EVALUATION

The technical bids will be opened online before the technical committee and the same will be evaluated as per the qualification criteria given and relevant documents in support of them. Commercial bids from only technically qualified bidders will be opened online before the committee. The decision of the committee will be final.

7.2 PRELIMINARY SCRUTINY

Prior to the detailed evaluation, the Purchaser will determine the substantial responsiveness of each offer to the tender documents. For purpose of this Clause, a substantially responsive bid is one which is in conformity with all the terms and conditions of the Tender Documents without any material deviations. The Purchaser's determination of an offer's responsiveness will be based on the contents of the tender offer itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. The KBCNMU will scrutinize the offers in respect of their completeness, submission of technical documents duly signed, etc. The Purchaser will short-list technically qualified bidders based on compliance of the qualifying criteria. In no circumstances will any deviation in specifications, eligibility criteria be allowed. The bidders are requested to read the tender document carefully, clarify all the doubts and ensure to comply with all the instructions herein. Non-compliance of any of the instructions contained in this document may disqualify the bidder from the tendering exercise.

7.3 CLARIFICATION OF OFFERS

To assist in the scrutiny, evaluation and comparison of offers, the Purchaser may, at its discretion, ask some or all the Bidders for clarification of their offers on any of the points mentioned (in written clarification or additional documents whichever required) therein and the same may be sent through an email. However, in such cases, original copy of the technical clarifications shall be sent to the Purchaser through e-mail, courier or in person, for official records. The request for such clarifications and the response shall be in writing.

7.4 PRICE COMPARISONS

The Purchaser will evaluate Commercial Offers of only short listed technically qualified Bidders. After opening Commercial Offers of the short-listed Bidders, they will be determined to be substantially responsive before comparing the commercial bids submitted by the bidders. If there exists any discrepancy between words and figures, the lower amount indicated will be considered.



7.5 NO COMMITMENT TO ACCEPT LOWEST OR ANY TENDER

The University is not to bind to accept lowest tenders, and University reserves the right to accept or reject, cancel, any or all offers, including those received late, or incomplete tenders from any or all the parties without assigning reason thereof. The Purchaser reserves the right to make changes in terms and conditions of the tender. The Purchaser will not be obliged to meet and have discussions with any of the Bidder and / or to give a hearing on their representations.

7.6 CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES

The Purchaser requires that the Bidders bidding for this bid should observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, the Purchaser defines the terms set forth as follows:

- i) "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of the public official in award of the tender.
- ii) "fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence award of contract to the detriment of the Purchaser, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Purchaser of the benefits of the free and open competition;
- iii) The Purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it is prima-facie established that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.

8 SIGNING OF CONTRACT

- i. The successful Bidder shall execute an agreement on Rs.500/- stamp paper, for contract in a format as per Annexure – G, within 30 days from issue of the Purchase Order' from KBCNMU. In exceptional circumstances, on request of the successful bidder in writing for extension, university authority reserves the right to grant an extension for appropriate period after getting satisfied with the reasons given. Considering the product and specifications, KBCNMU reserves the right to eliminate, modify or alter some of the contract terms given in Annexure – G.
- ii. The successful Bidder shall submit Security Deposit in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank or online mode through NEFT/RTGS at the time of signing the agreement.
- iii. On failure of execution of the agreement by the successful bidder, E.M.D. furnished will be forfeited.
- iv. Terms and conditions of the contract may vary from product to product and so accordingly some changes may be made even at the time of signing the agreement.



8.1 RESPONSIBILITIES OF BIDDER

As per the scope of work and technical specifications mentioned in this tender document.

8.2 QUALITY OF PRODUCTS & SERVICE

The Hardware / Software / Service must confirm to the scope of work given and of desired quality. Hence only well-known brands should be quoted and assembled brands are not eligible for this e-tender. It will be the prerogative of the University to select the brand /company on the basis of technical specifications, past experience regarding performance of the brand, market reputation of the brand etc. The University is looking for well proven branded products conforming to ISO standards similar to 9002 etc., which are volume produce and are used by a large number of users in India / Abroad. All products quoted should be associated with specific model numbers and names and with printed literature describing configuration and functionality.

8.3 REPEAT ORDER

Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University (KBCNMU) reserves the right to extend or terminate the period of contract depending on the performance of the vendor. The University also reserves the right to delete / increase / decrease items from the schedule of requirement specified in the tender.

8.4 CONSORTIUM / JOINT VENTURE (JV)

Any form of Consortium, Joint Venture is NOT allowed under this tender.

8.5 EXTENSION OF DELIVERY PERIOD / DELAY

As soon as it becomes apparent to the vendor that the delivery date(s) stipulated in the Supply Order(s) cannot be adhered to, Vendor should apply for extension to the officer(s) who placed the supply order(s) giving reasons for the delay and also the date up to which extension is required. Only after approval of the request from concern dept, will the extension period be considered.

8.6 RISK SUPPLY

In case the Vendor fails to deliver the service/hardware as stipulated in the delivery schedule, the university reserves the right to purchase the same or similar hardware / software / components / services from alternate sources/vendors at the risk, cost and responsibility of the selected bidder and the cost of the same will be recovered from the bidder's bills or PBG.

8.7 TAXES AND DUTIES

Rates under this tender should be quoted, inclusive of all taxes, GST etc. (bifurcating the taxes)



9 Other General Terms & Conditions

9.1 PAYMENT TERMS

100% payment shall ordinarily be made within 45 days after satisfactory installation and report received from technical authority appointed by the University or concerned school / administrative H.O.D / officer.

The successful bidder should submit a printed original bill with GST mentioning the **University's GST No. 27AAAJN0465A1ZL** while submitting the payment. Proof of payment of the GST amount in the bill (i.e. 2A statement generated for the bidder against the submitted invoice) will be required to be submitted to the government. The payment will be made within 45 days after the recommendation of concern department (and if required technical committee) regarding the satisfactory performance of work.

9.2 CANCELLATION OF PURCHASE ORDER

University reserves the right to cancel the purchase order in case bidder fails to execute the Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning (SITC) of CCTV Camera System, within the stipulated time. The University reserves the right to go for next lowest bidder, or other appropriate action will be taken.

If due to the above-mentioned reason purchase order is canceled, earnest money and security deposit shall be forfeited and also the tender may be allotted to the next lowest bidder or the university reserves the right to take any other appropriate decision including legal action against the bidder to whom purchase order was given.

9.3 EMD FORFIET SCENARIOS

The bidder's E.M.D. will be forfeited -

- (a) When the bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity specified in the bid.
- (b) In case of successful bidder, if he -
 - (i) fails to sign the contract/ agreement in accordance with the terms of the tender documents
 - (ii) fails to furnish required performance security deposit in accordance with the terms of the tender documents
 - (iii) fails or refuses to honor his quoted price for the product offer

9.4 WARRANTY

The standard warranty period for each items of this CCTV Camera System, will be of 01 years from the date of Installations.

9.5 CCTV Network Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) and Service Level Agreement (SLA)

1. Warranty and AMC Period



- 1.1 The complete CCTV Surveillance System supplied and installed under this tender shall be covered by a comprehensive warranty for a period of One (1) year from the date of successful installation, testing and commissioning and acceptance by the University.
- 1.2 After completion of the one-year comprehensive warranty period, the successful bidder shall provide Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for a further period of Three (3) years.
- 1.3 Thus, the total service support period shall comprise One (1) year comprehensive warranty + Three (3) years Comprehensive AMC.
- 1.4 The AMC shall commence immediately after expiry of the one-year warranty period, without any break in maintenance support.
2. **Scope of Comprehensive AMC**
 - 2.1 The AMC shall cover preventive and corrective maintenance of the complete CCTV Surveillance System, including CCTV cameras, NVRs, storage devices, network switches, racks, monitors/displays, UPS and associated accessories, cabling, connectors and other CCTV-related equipment supplied and installed under this tender.
 - 2.2 The bidder shall be responsible for keeping the complete CCTV surveillance system in satisfactory working condition throughout the AMC period.
 - 2.3 Being a Comprehensive AMC, the bidder shall repair or replace defective components/parts required for maintaining the system in operational condition, without any additional cost to the University, except for items specifically excluded in the tender.
 - 2.4 Replacement components shall be genuine, compatible and of equivalent or better specifications than the original components.
3. **Preventive Maintenance**
 - 3.1 Preventive maintenance shall be carried out at least once every quarter during the AMC period.
 - 3.2 Preventive maintenance shall include, but shall not be limited to:-
 - Cleaning and physical inspection of CCTV cameras.
 - Checking camera positioning, image quality and focus.
 - Checking NVR health, recording status and storage capacity.
 - Checking network switches, connectivity and associated network equipment.
 - Checking power supply, UPS and related connections.
 - Checking cables, connectors and terminations.
 - Verification of date/time synchronization and recording.
 - Checking overall system performance and availability.
 - 3.3 A quarterly preventive maintenance report shall be submitted to the authorized officer of the University.



4. **Service Level Agreement (SLA)**

- 4.1 The bidder shall provide a designated contact person/helpdesk for registration and monitoring of CCTV-related complaints.
- 4.2 All complaints reported by the University shall be acknowledged by the bidder within 04 hours of reporting.
- 4.3 The bidder shall attend to the complaint and, wherever required, depute a qualified service engineer within 24 hours of notification.
- 4.4 Critical Faults: Faults affecting a significant number of cameras, NVRs, storage systems, network switches, or surveillance of important/critical locations shall be treated as Critical Faults and shall normally be restored within 48 hours of reporting.
- 4.5 Non-Critical Faults: Individual camera faults or other non-critical faults shall normally be rectified within 3 working days of reporting.
- 4.6 Where immediate repair or replacement of a major component is not possible, the bidder shall provide a suitable temporary replacement, wherever technically feasible, to restore surveillance coverage.

5. **System Availability**

- 5.1 The bidder shall maintain a minimum overall 95% operational availability of the CCTV surveillance system during the AMC period.
- 5.2 Downtime caused by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the bidder, including natural calamities, force majeure, vandalism, major power failure, or failure of University-provided infrastructure/services, shall be excluded from the calculation of system availability, subject to verification and acceptance by the University.

6. **Penalty for SLA Non-Compliance**

- 6.1 In case of failure to comply with the prescribed response time or restoration time, the University may levy a penalty of ₹500/- per affected camera per day of delay.
- 6.2 The maximum aggregate penalty shall not exceed 10% of the annual AMC value in any financial year, irrespective of the number of complaints, affected cameras or instances of delay.
- 6.3 The applicable penalty, if any, shall be recovered/deducted from the AMC payment due to the bidder.
- 6.4 No penalty shall be imposed where the delay is due to circumstances specifically excluded under Clause 5.2, subject to verification and acceptance by the University.
- 6.5 Repeated failure to comply with the SLA, excessive downtime or unsatisfactory maintenance shall be treated as unsatisfactory performance. The University may issue a written warning and, in case of continued non-compliance, may take appropriate action including non-renewal or termination of the AMC, as per the terms and conditions of the tender.



7. Repair and Replacement

- 7.1 The bidder shall provide all necessary service, labor and technical support required for maintenance covered under the Comprehensive AMC. No separate visiting, service or labor charges shall be payable by the University.
- 7.2 Any component replaced under the Comprehensive AMC shall be of genuine make and equivalent or better specification than the original component.
- 7.3 The bidder shall ensure that replacement components are compatible with the installed CCTV system and do not adversely affect system performance.
- 7.4 Any defective component replaced under the AMC shall be handed over to the University, wherever applicable.

8. Maintenance Records and Reporting

- 8.1 The bidder shall maintain proper records of complaints received, response time, attendance, faults identified, corrective action, components repaired/replaced, downtime and restoration time.
- 8.2 The bidder shall submit a quarterly AMC/SLA performance report to the authorized officer of the University.

9. Technical Support

- 9.1 The bidder shall provide necessary technical support for NVR configuration, recording-related issues, camera connectivity, network configuration, firmware/software-related issues and restoration of CCTV services during the AMC period.
- 9.2 The bidder shall provide necessary assistance for system health checks, configuration backup and restoration of the CCTV system whenever required by the University.

10. Additional Equipment

- 10.1 The AMC shall cover the CCTV equipment and infrastructure supplied and installed under this tender.
- 10.2 Any additional CCTV equipment installed subsequently and not covered under this tender shall be brought under AMC only with the approval of the University and at mutually agreed rates, wherever applicable.

11. Payment of AMC Charges

- 11.1 The AMC charges shall be payable for the Three (3) year AMC period after completion of the one-year warranty period, as quoted in the Financial Bid.
- 11.2 AMC charges shall be paid [quarterly] subject to satisfactory performance and certification by the authorized officer of the University.
- 11.3 Applicable penalties, if any, shall be deducted from the AMC payment.



- 11.4 Payment shall be subject to submission of the required maintenance reports and satisfactory compliance with the AMC and SLA conditions.

12. Overall Responsibility

- 12.1 The bidder shall be responsible for ensuring satisfactory operation and maintenance of the complete CCTV surveillance system throughout the Three (3) year AMC period.
- 12.2 The bidder shall provide adequate technically qualified manpower and necessary resources to meet the AMC and SLA requirements specified in this tender.

9.6 SUPPORT PLAN OF BIDDER

The selected bidder (L-1) shall submit the management, maintenance & support plan which will include details of contact and escalation matrix within 30 Days of receiving of Work Order. Also selected bidder (L-1) should share the inventory details of all Hardware under this project with KBCNMU, Jalgaon in coordination with concern department for inventory management, post implementation of the project.

9.7 Delivery & Penalty

The CCTV Camera System as mentioned in the scope must be supplied within 6 weeks from the date of receipt of purchase order. If the successful bidder fails to deliver goods/material within the period prescribed for delivery, the University will entitle to recover penalty as liquidated damages @ 0.5% of total value of invoice each week or parts thereof during which the delay of such stores delays subject to maximum in limit of 5% of the approved project cost for the bidder.

9.8 INDEMNITY

Service Support partner shall indemnify, protect and save the indenter/buyer against all claims, losses, costs damages, expenses, action suits and other proceeding, resulting from infringement of any patent, trademarks, copyrights, licenses etc. or such other statutory infringements in respects of all the hardware and software supplied by him.

9.9 PUBLICITY

Any publicity by the vendor in which the name of the indenter/buyer is to be used should be done only with the explicit written permission of the indenter/buyer. The vendors shall not make copy of award of contract at their own end. It will be seen as violation of the terms and condition of the contract.



9.10 **ARBITRATION**

- 9.9.1 The indenter/buyer and the Vendor shall make every effort to resolve amicably, by direct negotiation, any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the any of the or part of the terms and conditions of the contract. Parties may refer the disagreement to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the University and his decision will be binding on both the parties.
- 9.9.2 If within thirty days from the commencement of such negotiations, the indenter /buyer and the Vendor have been unable to resolve dispute amicably, the parties agree that in respect of those matters, as are not defined in the terms and conditions of this Dispute Resolution Clause, or anywhere else in the Contract, the same shall be decided and settled by mutually appointed third party Arbitrator, in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the amendments thereof as in operation on the date of execution of the Contract. As a sole arbitrator, his decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- 9.9.3 The place of Arbitration shall be Jalgaon and all costs relating to the Arbitration proceedings shall be borne equally by both the parties. The parties agree that the language for making all the documentation, decisions, orders and resolutions will be English.

9.11 **SURVEY AND INFORMATION FOR ON SITE AS-IS CONDITION:**

KBCNMU recommends Bidders for site inspection and survey to understand the physical locations and technical feasibility conditions of the campus area. Such Survey will be done by bidder at its own cost before submission of the tender, if needed by the bidder.

9.12 **LEGAL JURISDICTION**

The courts at Jalgaon alone will have the jurisdiction to try any Matter, dispute or reference between parties arising out of this tender / contract. It is specifically agreed that no court outside and other than Jalgaon court shall have Jurisdiction in the matter. All legal disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of Civil Courts Jalgaon only.

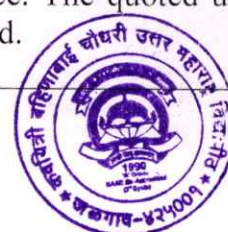

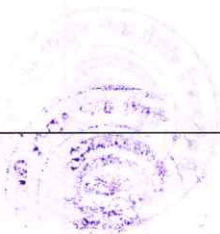

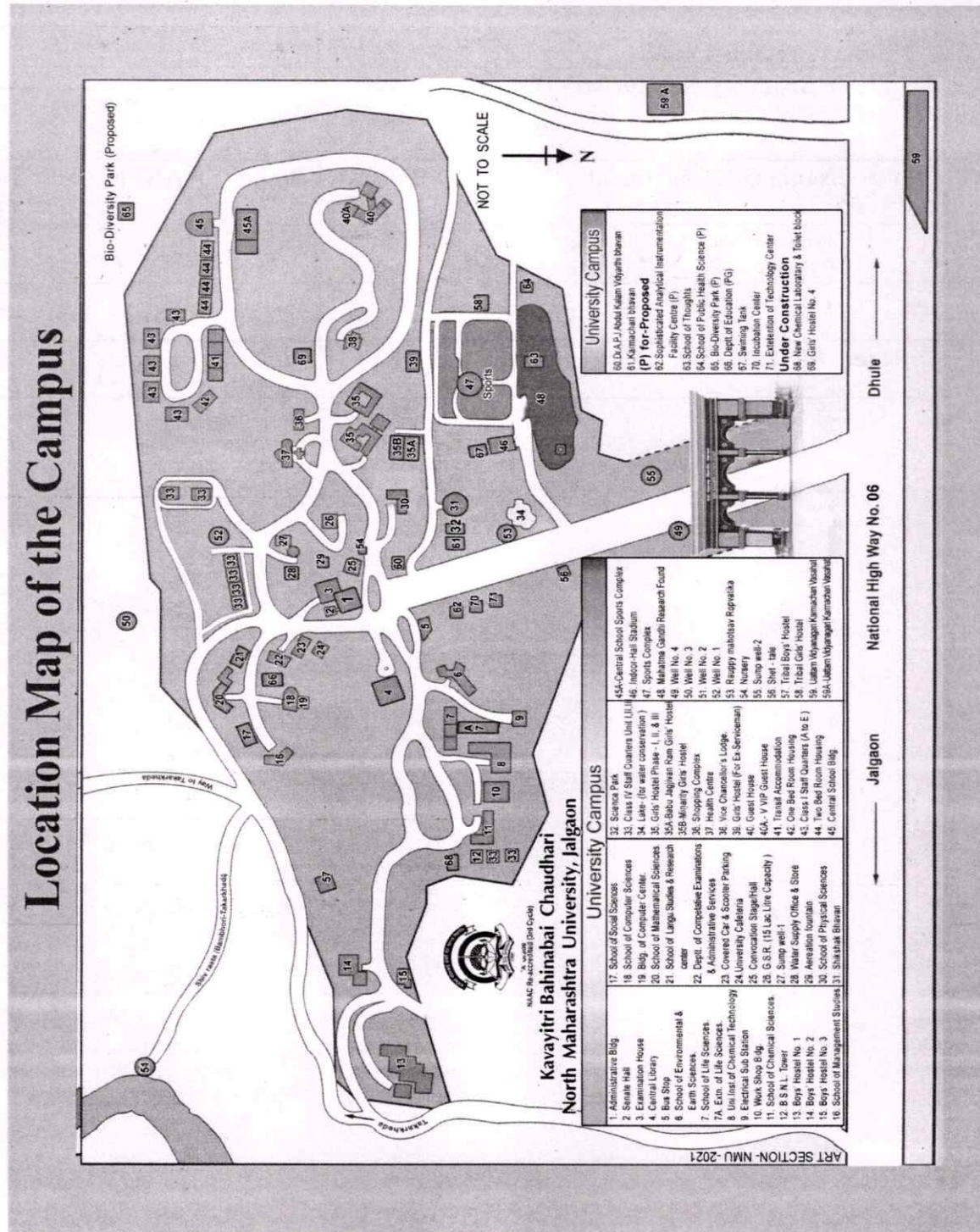
